Warm-up Procedure

Lanes 1 and 8 will be used for starts.
Lanes 2 to 6 will be used for warm up.
NO DIVING IN LANES 2 TO 6.

Marshalling

Marshalling will take place in the tent between the food and the caravan. Marshalling numbers will be displayed. Marshalled events will be called over the PA system. It is the swimmers' responsibility to be at marshalling at the appropriate time.
PLEASE BE AWARE SOME EVENTS WILL GO TO STRAIGHT FINALS.

Some Age Champions events will be swum as finals in the Saturday evening session. These swimmers do not need to report to Marshalling until the finals session. However if the swimmer is in another event, eg 200m or open swim they are required to marshal for those events as normal. Wide Bay will not be responsible if a swimmer misses an event.
