- Warm up: Friday February 19th at 6.00 p.m. Session Starts at 6.30pm
- Warm up: Saturday February 20th at 7.00am. Session Starts at 8.30am
- Meet will be run as timed finals.
- Medals awarded to the first three places in each event, excluding 7 yrs & under. Please be aware that Junior Rule Tolerances exclude swimmers 7 yrs & under from being disqualified. Referees are not to be approached on this rule.
- Age Champions will be awarded to both male and female in each age group - with the exception of 7 yrs and under
- Points not awarded for the Open 50m Freestyle, 200 metre, 400 metre, 800 metre and 1500 metre events.
- Swimming Queensland rules will apply
- Nominations close on Friday February 12, 2010
- Nominations accepted via e-mail or disc for Team Manager or Meet Manager
- Hardcopy and cheque must be mailed to PO Box 688, Pialba, QLD 4655 and **must be received before your nominations will be entered into the program.**
- Three time keepers per lane, participating clubs will be required to assist.
