

# Winter Short Course - 2010

## Information sheet

The following information is provided with the aim of making your weekend enjoyable and relaxing as possible.

### Meet Program

The meet program has attracted 1081 nominations from 171 swimmers representing 22 clubs from Brisbane to Townsville.

### Estimated Session Times:

Saturday 1pm to 6.05pm – does not include a break

Sunday 8.30am to 12.15pm – does not include a lunch break.

- **These times are based on nominating times and do not take into account any NT's or condensing of heats.**

### Gates open

Gates open at 11.00am Saturday and 7am Sunday.

### Parking:

There is parking along the front of the pool in 3 rows and long side the pool complex in one row. Please do not park in the disabled car park or across a gate way.

### Pool entry:

Pool entry will be \$2 for 7 years and over with no charge for swimmers and coaches. Please respect Fairymead and make sure you enter through the BACK GATES. Programs and raffles will also be sold from the gate on arrival. There is no charge for entry on Sunday but a raffle/money board will be on the gate.

### Warm Up:

Warm up is 12noon to 12.45pm Saturday and 7.15am to 8.15am on Sunday..

### Shade

Shade is the responsibility of each club.. You can set up tents from 8:30am on Saturday.

Presentations this year will be streamlined as swimmers will need to be aware of marshalling due to the multi aged events. For younger swimmers we will have the dias set up with a set of medals available during the day if a parent would like photos.
